



## **Port Congestion Information**

**\*Updated\* 6/26/18**

Dear Valued Customer,

As with many carriers, COSCO has vessels that are being affected by congestion at various ports. We have listed the current areas where we have received information of congestion affecting shipment arrivals. In many areas, we must strictly control and monitor transshipment space in order to prevent further delays. We hope this information will help you better plan your shipments.

- 1) Due to seriously port congestion at Douala, the Lome---Douala feeder vessel will wait for berth nearly 14 days, more than 200teu cargo pending at Lome more than 14 days.
- 2) Currently North America transshipment cargo via Shanghai & Ningbo to Karachi and Mundra, are severely overbooked with nearly 1500 teus pending at Shanghai, Ningbo or Singapore more than 14 days.
- 3) The following areas have feeder space limitation in order to avoid overbooking and cargo pending at transshipment points.
  - Kwangyang (via Shanghai)
  - Incheon (via Shanghai and Ningbo)
  - Karachi (via Shanghai and Ningbo)
  - Mundra (via Shanghai and Ningbo)
